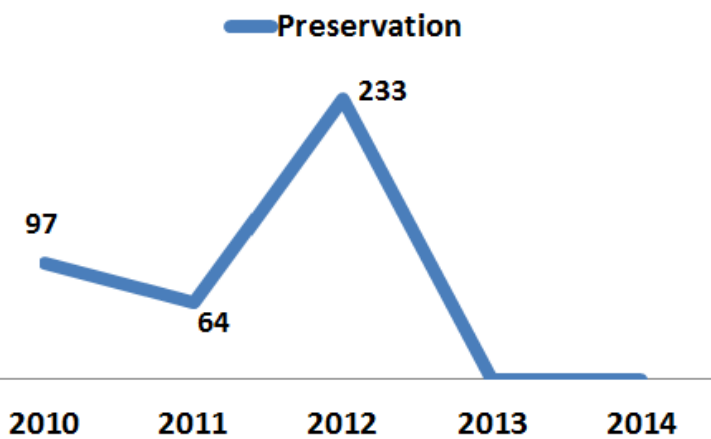


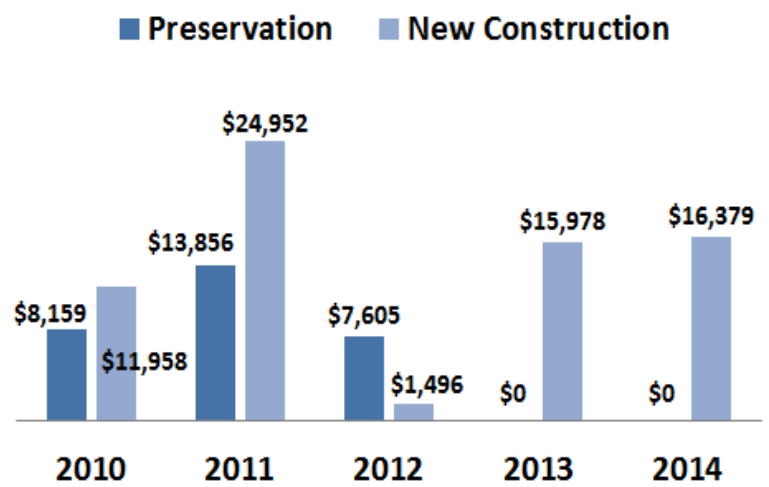
LIHTC ALLOCATIONS

The **Low Income Housing Tax Credit** is a critical resource for preserving and improving affordable housing. The chart below shows how **Hawaii** has allocated 9% and 4% tax credits for preservation from **2003-2014**.

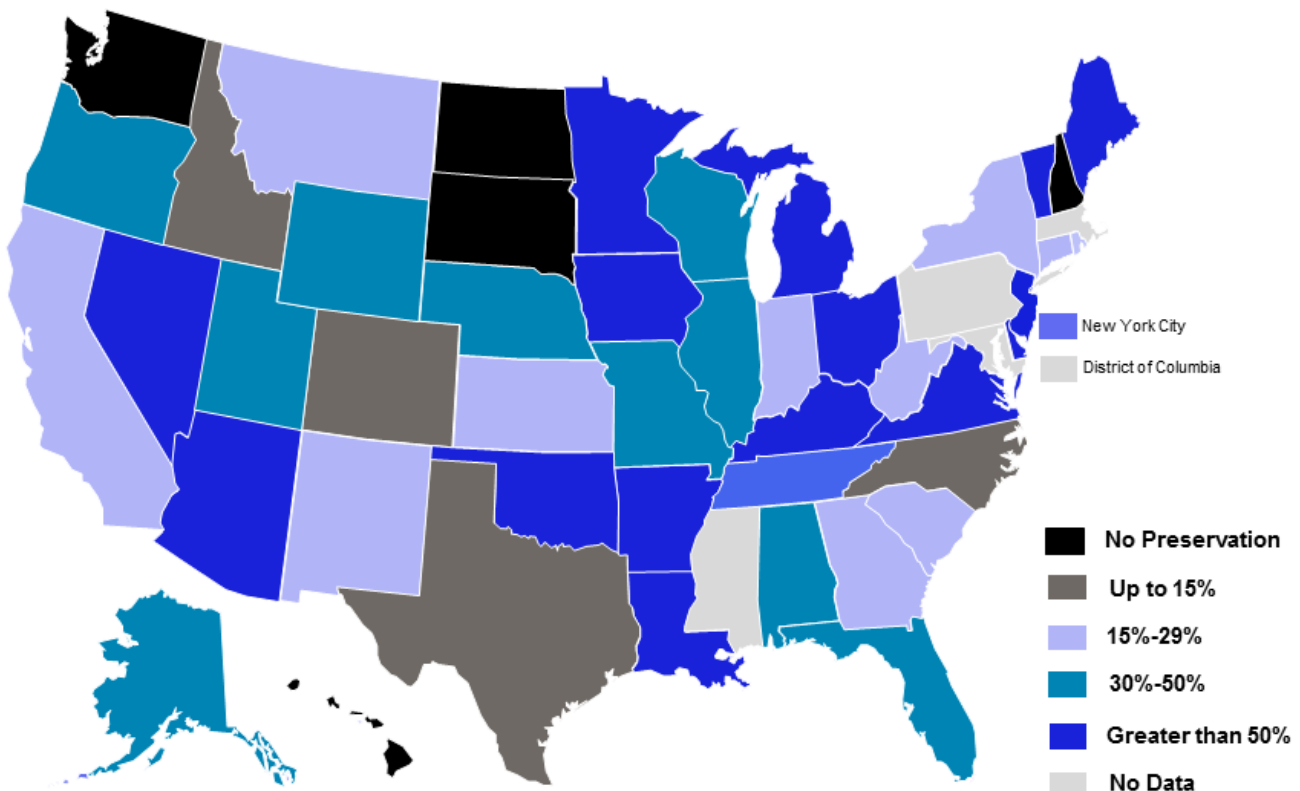
